

Dear Passport Scholarship Applicant:

This scholarship is designed for students who are intending to participate in study abroad programs while attending Bennett College. Therefore, priority for passport funds will be given to students who are in freshman, sophomore, and junior status that are first time passport holders.

Submit your application and essay to the Center for Global Studies on the top floor of Race Hall.

Note: Your essays should be thoughtfully written and grammatically correct.

As with other scholarship applications, we recommend that you have your essays reviewed in the Writing Center or by one of your mentors. **Unacceptable essays will be returned for corrections.** You will be notified when your application has been approved.

After approval, our office will complete the necessary paperwork which will provide you with two (2) checks: (1) U.S. Department of State (2) Register of Deeds (Guilford County).

Note: These checks are good for only 90 days after they are written by the Finance office. Get your documents ASAP!

Directions

- A). Provide proof of necessary documents: **ORIGINAL COPY** (*not a photocopy*) of you **certified** birth certificate, state issued ID, Bennett ID, social security card (these are **REQUIRED** to get your passport.)
- B). If you receive your passport check, you will need to report to the Register of Deeds in the BB&T Building downtown. Their address is 201 W Market St, 1st Floor – Room 108. Greensboro, NC 27401. They are a **WALK IN clinic** – no appointments needed.
- C). You will receive an email at your (BENNETT EMAIL ADDRESS ONLY) from the global studies office when your checks are ready!
